The safety of residents, staff, and visitors is paramount. Please help us maintain a safe environment by obeying all signs and following safety directions in and around construction zones.

- **Winter Safety:** Please take extra care outdoors to prevent slips and falls.
 - Use the **provided salt bins** for icy areas.
 - Wear **non-slip footwear**.
 - Walk cautiously using the "**Penguin Shuffle**" technique.
 - Keep your hands free for balance and stay on designated walkways.
- **Noise:** If you are affected by construction noise, free hearing protection is available from the Support Services offices on the second floor of the Perley Centre.

Andrew Fleck Children's Services Intergenerational Early Learning Centre at Perley Health Update (Project Completion: 82%)

The project is delayed by 20 days and is now expected to be completed by the end of May.

Ongoing interior and exterior work through to April 13 includes:

Exterior Work

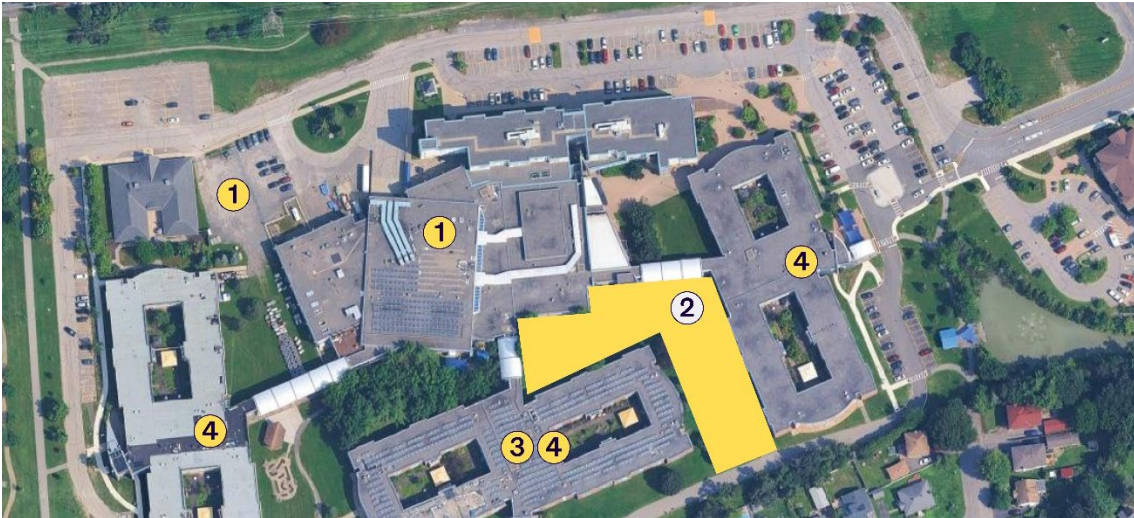
1. **Roofing and HVAC Equipment:** Workers are finishing the roof layers on the Perley building and installing the **HVAC** (Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning) units.
2. **Siding, Soffit, and Fascia Installation:** These are the finishing touches on the roof's edge, the underside and the walls.
3. **Exterior Lights:** Installation of the final outdoor safety and architectural lighting.

Interior Work

1. **Hoarding Wall Removal:** Crews will be taking down parts of the hoarding walls in the hallways across from Deborah's Gift Boutique. These are the temporary walls used to shield the public from dust, noise, and debris during construction.
2. **Corridor Wall Finishing:** Final patches and painting of the hallway walls.
3. **Sprinkler Tie-In:** This is an important safety step where the new fire sprinkler pipes are officially connected to the building's main water supply.

4. **Flooring and Millwork:** Work continues to install the floors and the millwork - such as the cabinetry, shelving, floor trim, and baseboards.
5. **Ceiling Tiles:** The crew will be installing the acoustic tiles into the ceiling grid to hide the wiring and pipes above.

In Progress

1. **Perley Centre Re-roofing:** Work continues but the schedule is subject to change if there is inclement weather.
 - The staff parking lot next to Respite House remains closed to accommodate the work.
 - Please use other designated staff parking areas.

2. **Intergenerational Early Learning Centre:** See the update on reverse.
3. **Ottawa Residence Repairs:** Construction repairs are underway to address water damage resulting from the Ottawa roof leak.
4. **Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Enhancements:** Enhancements continue throughout the Ottawa, Rideau and Gatineau Residences with the installation of new dampers and ceiling thermostats in resident rooms. Installation takes approximately 30 minutes per room with minimal noise.
 - Residents and guests do not need to leave the room.
 - Contractors work primarily in the ceiling area in the centre of the room.
 - A member of the housekeeping team will be available to assist with cleanup and resident support.
